# **Keynote Speakers**



Prof. Wrobel was born in Bremen in 1968, is married and has three children. After training in banking, he studied economics at the Christian Albrechts University in Kiel from 1990 to 1996 and received his doctorate between 1996 and 1999. sc.pol. (PhD scholarship from the Konrad Adenauer Foundation). The dissertation dealt with the transformation process in Estonia. From 1999 to 2001 he worked as a lecturer for economic policy at the University of Tartu in Estonia, then as a dean's officer at the Faculty of Political Science at the University of Erfurt. In 2004 he was appointed to the West Saxon University of Zwickau. In December 2019 he received his doctorate.



Abdulmelik Alkan, Head of International Relations office at International Black Sea University, teaching International Relations courses. Mr. Alkan is PhD.c in the University of Georgia, does research on Turkey and South Caucasus. He founded <a href="https://www.caucasusreference.net">www.caucasusreference.net</a> first Modern Political Dictionary of South Caucasus. Mr. Alkan is currently working on the book titled as Turkey and Georgian Diplomacy corpus analysis.



Vice-rector and associate professor of the University of Applied Psychology in Prague and Terezín, Czech Republic, long-term project manager and business consultant in development, investment, educational, and R&D&I projects. In the years 2017 – 2022, he worked as the Chief coordinator of the National Business Center (NPC) Nitra under the management of the Slovak Business Agency (SBA) and before that as an expert guarantor for cooperation between universities and the business sector at the Center for Scientific and Technical Information of the Slovak Republic under the management of the Ministry of Education, Science, research and sport of the Slovak Republic.



Fulbright Scholar at Illinois State University in Normal, Illinois (USA). After the honors in 1993 he became a research assistant at the Department of Economics at the Technical University of Zittau (now University of Applied Sciences Zittau-Görlitz) and the Department of Business Administration at the International Graduate School Zittau (now Technical University Dresden). In the winter semester 2013/2014 he accepted an appointment as Professor of Managerial Accounting and Internal Audit at WHZ Zwickau University of Applied Sciences. He is also managing partner of a consulting firm. His international experience, engagement and efforts were awarded by an honorary professorship and doctorate of the Tajik Technical University of Khujand in Feb. 2012-2019 he was honored with the honorary professorship of the KAFU due to the intensive project, research and teaching cooperation.On a private basis Prof. Brauweiler is since 1986 a licensed private pilot with night flying qualification and multi engine-rating and has currently ca. 700 hours of flight experience.
